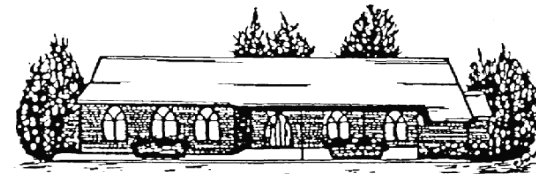


**Christ the King

CHRIST THE KING

Hopefully this feast will not be seen to have anything to do with the republican debate. As he tells Pilate, Christ's kinship is 'out of this world'. As the readings suggest, it is concerned with God's ultimate victory. It is an expression of Christ's ongoing work of restoring all of creation to its proper relationship with God. This is the work of changing and shaping human society, and the environment on which it depends, so that it reflects more fully the creative design of God. We need to talk about dreams and visions today, about the fact that human language always falls short when it has to speak about God and ultimate realities. Today's liturgy makes it clear that, even though we may call Jesus a king, his form of authority bears no relationship at all to earthly kings. The purpose of this feast is to summon us to a different view of reality, namely, that Jesus Christ is the source of our hope, continuity and stability. We are part of God's royal family. What is your role in the royal society of the kingdom of God in our midst? (Break open the Word - 2006)

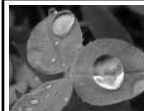
